

City Council Meeting Minutes

October 10, 2023

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS MET ON THIS DAY IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE CITY OF MUNDAY FIRE DEPARTMENT AT 6:00 PM. Mayor Robert Bowen called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Council members present were Council Person Singleton, Council Person White, Council Person Smith and Council Person Longan.

There were no public comments at this time.

Grant Request for Munday Volunteer Fire Dept

Council Person White thanked the Fire Department for coming to the meeting. Troy Parton discussed the current rodeo arena will be turned into a softball field so they have acquired land from Susan Gulley by the grain elevators. The total cost for the arena will be \$180,000 The EDC grant that is being presented is for \$75,000, the county has given \$50,000. Council Person Singleton made a motion to approve the Grant of \$75,000 to the Munday Fire Department from the EDC B Board and Council Person Smith seconded. The vote was 3 for and 1 abstained.

Road Closure

The Fire Department will be building the new Rodeo Arena on lots that are located on South Cedar, East Eden and East Forest St which would require for those to be closed. They currently aren't paved roads but used to be roads by the grain elevators that will need to be deemed closed. Also Kyle Bibb with the Fire Dept would like the water main located for the concession stand water meter. Council Person Longan made a motion to approve closing the roads and Council Person Smith seconded. The vote was 3 for 1 abstained.

Property Lease

AMA Techtel would like to discuss leasing property on North 9th and Main Street to put a move ready office/portable building. There is no zoning currently but the property will need to be kept up. Council Person White made a motion to lease the property to AMA Techtel and Council Person Smith seconded. All present voted for.

Halloween Closure

A map of the normal route from Bowie to Houston and South 9th to South 5th was presented for safe trick or treating. The Fire Department will be available to help close off the roads. Trick or Treating will be from 5:30pm to 8pm. Council Person Smith made a motion to approve road closures and Council Person Smith seconded. All present voted for.

All previous minutes, reports and financial statements were reviewed with no questions. Council Person Singleton made a motion to approve all previous minutes, reports and financial statements. Council Person Smith seconded. All present were in favor.
