

City Council Meeting Minutes
Regular Meeting
August 20, 2024

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS MET ON THE DAY IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE CITY MUNDAY CONFERENCE ROOM AT 6:00 PM. Mayor Robert Bowen, called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Council members present were Mayor Pro- Tem Karen Longan, Councilwoman Exalee Smith, Councilwoman Jayla Sanchez, Councilwoman Joyce Sanders and Councilwoman Skye Urbancyk.

Invocation- Jay Cage/ Pledge Mayor Pro -Tem Karen Longan.

Public comments: Tray Singleton came before the Council with a concern about the parking on N. Main and presented photos showing vehicles being illegally parked wrong and feels that the city needs to address this issue before an accident may occur and be directed to the Chief of Police.

Item 1: Hear, discuss and consider proposed Tax rate for 2024. City Manager David Trevino briefly explained to the Council and presented information submitted from Mitzi on tax rate. After a discussion was held, the Council went to the next item.

Item 2: Heard, discuss, act on allowing the City of Munday to go into contract with the Knox County Appraisal District to perform the function of assessing and collecting taxes of the taxing unit for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. Mayor Robert Bowen's recommendation is to continue the contract with Knox County and asked for a motion. Councilwoman Exalee Smith motioned to approve and continue to contract with the Knox County Appraisal for 2024-2025 fiscal year, and seconded made by Mayor Pro tem Karen Longan.

Item 5: Heard, discuss, and act on approving a 2 year contract for Albert De Leon as new Chief of Police for the City of Munday. City manager David Trevino presented the contract for the Chief of Police drafted by the City Attorney Lina Trevino. City Manager David Trevino asked the Council if they had a chance to read over the contract and/or had any questions or anything else to be added to the contract. City manager David Trevino asked the Council if they were ready to move forward to take action or needed more time and can be postponed on the next Council meeting. The Council stated that they had reviewed the contract and didn't see an issue and were ready to move forwarded in taking action. Mayor Pro tem Karen Longan made the motion to approve the contract as presented for the new Chief of Police Albert De Leon, and seconded made by Councilwoman Exalee Smith.

Item 6: Heard, discuss, act on accepting or denying trust property bid by Roger Copeland for Block 1, Lot 6, Parrish Addition, Munday, Texas (R-9287). After the Council held a discussion, Mayor Pro Tem Karen Longan made the motion to accept the bid by Roger Copeland and seconded made by Councilwoman Exalee Smith.

Item 7: Heard, discuss, update on Munday swimming pool. City Manager David Trevino gave the Council an update and stated that the city had received the grant money for the repairs of the swimming and will possibly taking bids and hoping to start the repairs soon, to have it ready by summer time. After the Council held a discussion they moved on to the next item.

Item 9: Heard, discuss, act on setting date and time for Budget session. The City Council agreed in setting a date and time schedule for September 4, 2024 at 5:15 PM.
