THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS MET ON THIS DAY IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE CITY OF MUNDAY CONFERENCE ROOM AT 6:00 P.M. Mayor Chris Baker called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. Council members present: Joyce Sanders, Ryan Redder, Jayla Sanchez, Karen Longan and Skye Urbanczyk.

Item 1: Heard, discussed, and considered options for Munday swimming pool-

Discussed how it would be better to go to Plan B with rehabbing the Munday swimming pool. The Cost for the filling out the grant (250 pages) is \$7,500. The City has raised \$125,000. Need to put out to accept bids for the restoration of the pool. Mayor asked for a motion to accept Caleb Martinez for the Swimming pool rehab project. Councilman Karen Longan made a motion to accept Caleb Martinez to Rehab the Munday Swimming pool. Councilman Jayla Sanchez 2nd. All present and voted for. Motion passed.

Item 2: Heard, discussed update on sewer plant-

City Manager David Trevino discussed the rips in the liner at the Munday sewer plant. Had a company out of Midland (Mustang Extreme) to come out and survey the damage. The damage is repairable. The cost is \$10,600. The City will go forward with repair.

Item 3: Heard, discussed update on Drainage Storm pump-

City manager explained to Council that the City has 3 storm pumps. 2 large ones, and 1 smaller one. The City has been working off of one storm pump. The working pump (motor) was struck by lightning. The City had a motor on hand that worked. The City will purchase a new motor and get the 2nd large pump up and operational.

Item 4: Heard, discussed update with insurance claims-

City Manager explained that a claim was made to the TML insurance for the storm damage from April 29th. The swimming pool, and the City yard saw the most damaged.

Item 5: Heard, discussed water bills,

The Mayor and Council expressed their concerns about the water billing. The also expressed their concern with those on fixed incomes. City Manager informed The Mayor and Council that we have recently serviced the water meters, and how the city is working on getting the readings correct. There will be mistakes form time to time and the city will work with those cases as they arise. Council would like to get random reads each month.

Item 6: Heard, discussed City ordinances-

Informed Council about the property cleaned up at 231 N. 12th. House at 1250 W. Main has been cleared of oil barrels from front porch. Property owned by Jules Rizon is continuing to be cleaned up. Vehicle was removed from 1280 W. Main. Contacted owner of 18 wheeler being park at the City pool.

- E. City Managers report.

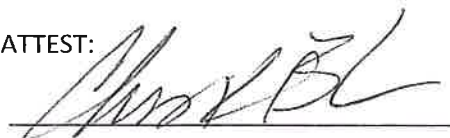
