

City Council Meeting Minutes

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNDAY, TEXAS MET ON THIS DAY IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE CITY OF MUNDAY CONFERENCE ROOM AT 6:00 P.M. Mayor Robert Bowen called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. Item 1: Hear, discuss, and consider hiring Government Capital Securities Corporation as the City's Municipal Advisor. The attached agreement specifies the terms of such agreement and the scope of the work. Drew addresses the Council and gave a background of the company and what services would be provided. Item 2: Hear, discuss, and consider Matt Pottysman's proposal for new website for the City of Munday. Matt came before the Council made a brief presentation on what the organization entails and advised the Council that he would need \$ 5,000.00 and begin by January 2025. After the Council held a discussion they agreed to bring the item back to the next Council meeting.

Item 3: Hear, discuss, consider and/or act on designating for safe treating for Halloween for the City of Munday. Mayor Pro-tem Karen Longan motion to act on approving a contingent fee with Perdue Brandon Fielder Collins and Mott, LLC pursuant to Section 552.0014(b) of the Texas Local Government Code, said contract being for the collection delinquent utility accounts owed to the City of Munday and notice of said contract is posted with the agenda in accordance with Section 2254 of the Government Code, seconded made by Councilwoman Jayla Sanchez.

Rebecca also stated to the Council that she working on Junk Vehicles notices in the future.

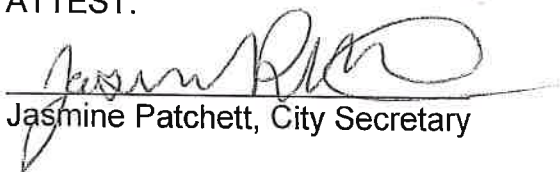
